March 12th Speaker — **Sherry Nicholson**, YAIPak Outreach



Sherry Nicholson is the founder and CEO of YAIPak Outreach, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit. Now an organization affecting over 1.4M lives, the heart of everything flows from Sherry's own experience of extravagant love.

While fleeing from an extremely abusive relationship, she experienced homelessness with her two small children. She knows what it's like to feel hopeless, rejected, and alone. But it was the extravagant love of God that radically transformed her life.

In May of 2016 Sherry founded YAIPak Outreach. YAI is an acronym for "You Are Important, People Administering Kindness", a message that she is determined to share with every person that she and her team encounter. YAIPak is a mobile outreach that goes into the places needing help the most. YAIPak focuses on building relationships with the under-resourced with the goal of leading every person to recovery and restoration.

In 7 short years, YAIPak Outreach calls Montgomery

County, TN their home and headquarters with a 35000 square foot warehouse; and a 2nd Chapter with fully functioning warehouse in Katy, TX. YAIPak has grown to support over 50 domestic nonprofits. They partner with numerous government agencies to meet the needs of homeless veterans, children in traumatic situations, and victims of natural disasters. They also send supplies to approximately 10 countries internationally through missionaries. She continues to develop programs to assist life change.

Sherry now chooses to touch the lives of others through that same extravagant love she has known firsthand. Sherry has been a licensed minister since 2003. She is married to Steve Nicholson, and they have 6 children and 16 grandchildren.
