Option 2:

Tennessee Room Block

- If there is enough interest, we can arrange for a Tennessee room block (three night minimum, \$300-\$350 per night) at a hotel within an hour of DC.
- **IF YOU WOULD BE INTERESTED IN BOOKING A ROOM IN A TENNESSEE ROOM BLOCK, PLEASE RESPOND TO THIS EMAIL IMMEDIATELY WITH HOW MANY ROOMS YOU WOULD NEED.** Most hotels are requiring 100% room block payment upfront, so we need to get an idea of how many rooms to book before we can proceed.

NOTE: For either option, you need to **contact your US Senator or Congressman to get a designated inauguration ticket**. Some have ticket request forms you can fill out online. There will be nonticketed areas on the mall, but they will be far away from the action.

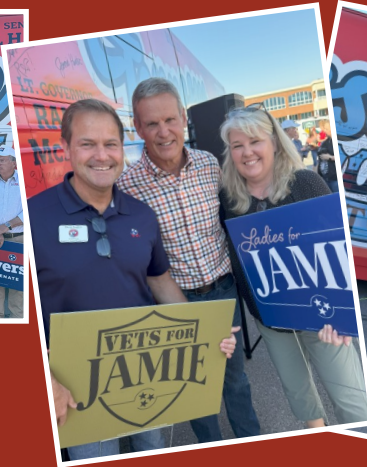
